



St. Philip Neri Catholic Church Endowment Fund



Many of you may not realize this, but OUR PARISH has its very own endowment fund.

What is an endowment fund? The St. Philip Endowment Fund came into existence because some of our parishioners have made charitable donations in the form of cash, stocks, mutual funds, real property, or other personal property.

How does an endowment work? The practice of investing the principal, rather than spending it, thus creating a perpetual fund (a forever-funding source to our parish). Most of our endowment's annual earnings can be distributed to our parish for its current needs, should we choose to withdraw them.

Where is the St. Philip's Endowment Fund? The St. Philip Endowment Fund is held within the Catholic Development Foundation. The Catholic Develop-

ment Foundation has an endowment fund established for every parish in our diocese and supports many other Catholic ministries and programs in our diocese as well. Learn more: cdfnd.org

There are many ways to contribute to an endowment fund. Here are a few:

1. **Will Planning** – Include St. Philip's Endowment Fund in your will.
2. **Life Insurance** – Name the St. Philip's Endowment Fund as a beneficiary of any existing or new policies.
3. **Outright Gifts** – Make a gift of cash, stocks or farm commodities to the Endowment Fund.

The bottom line is that charitable donations made to the St. Philip's Endowment Fund will help secure the future of our parish, our home of worship. It's a gift that keeps on giving and will live forever.

ND Tax Credit - In 2011, the ND legislatures passed a bill that allowed a very generous tax credit to those who make a charitable gift to a ND qualified endowment. If you are a ND resident and make a gift to a ND qualified endowment (like St. Philip's Endowment Fund) of \$5000 or more, you are eligible for a 40% tax credit on your ND taxes. Tax credits are much different than a tax deduction because they reduce your tax liability dollar for dollar. The maximum tax credit is \$10,000 for individuals or \$20,000 for married filing jointly. And, credits can be carried over for up to three years.

The Power of Endowment: An example of an endowment at 6% average net annual return and 3.5% average net grant payout.
