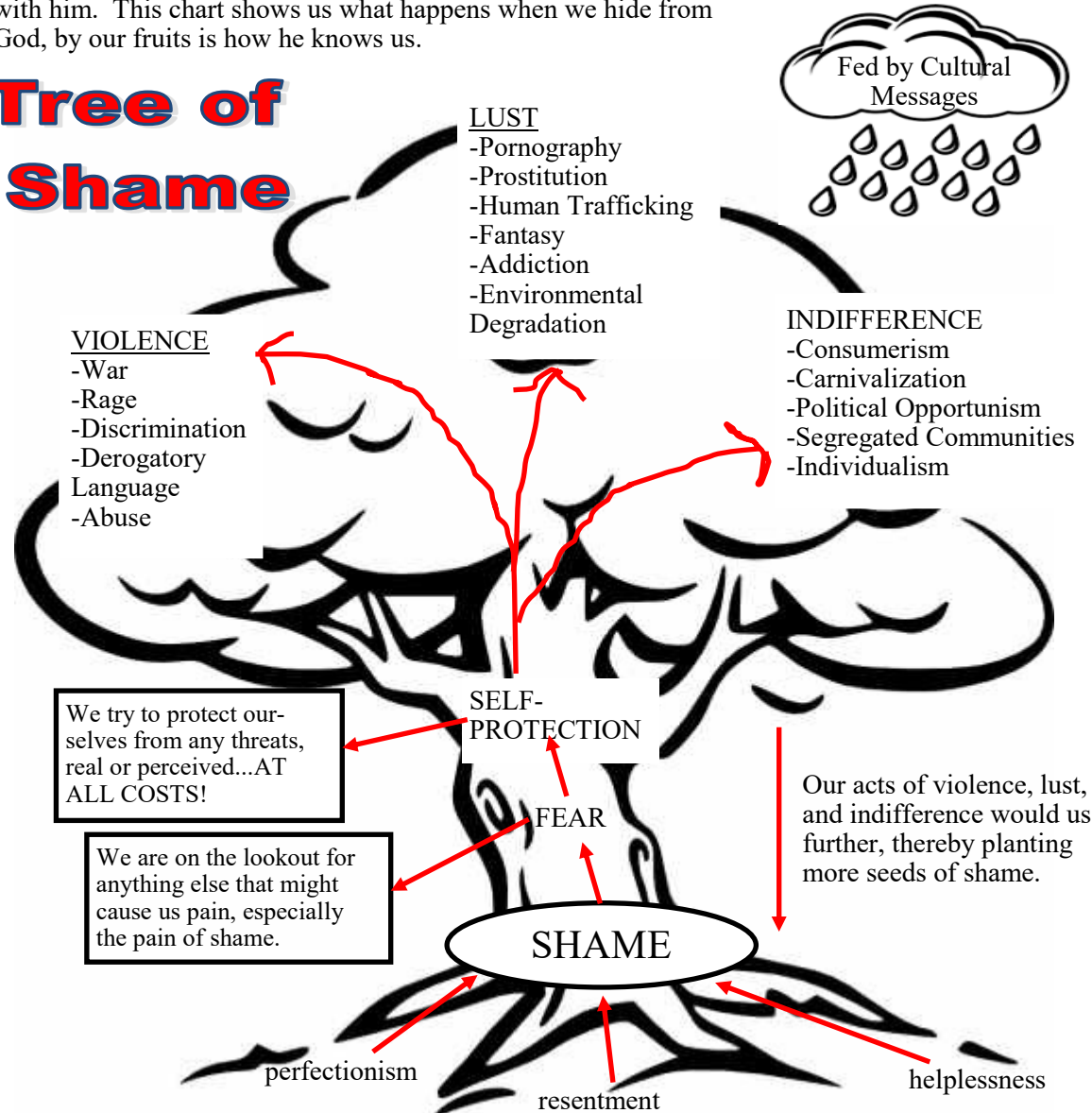

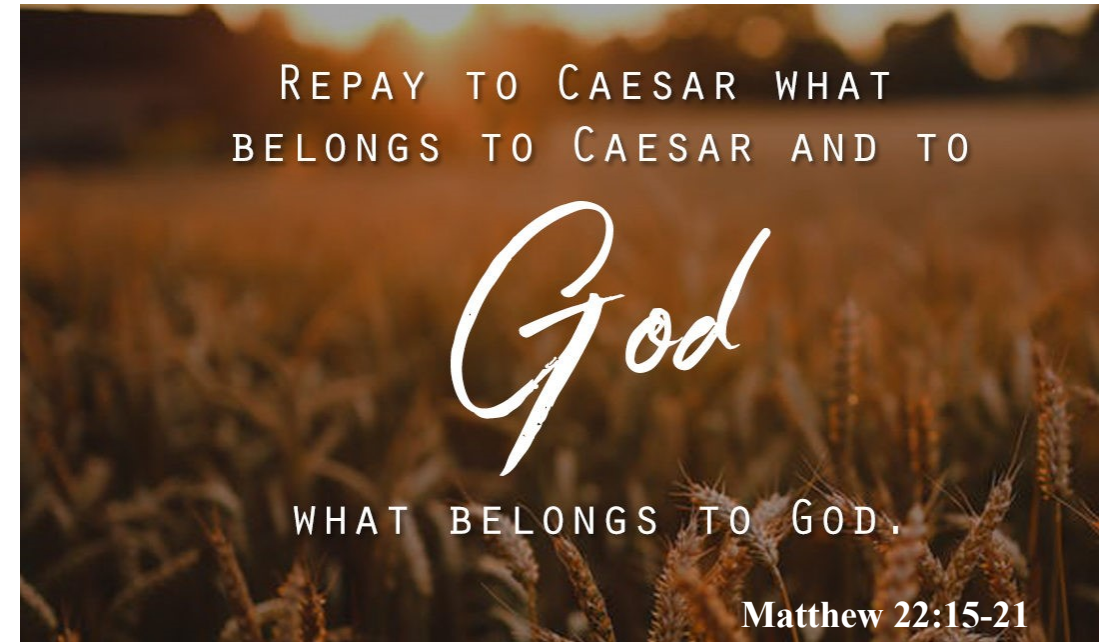
## Tree of Shame
