

Home Enthronement to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary

With the 100th Anniversary of the apparitions of Fatima coming up in October 2017, Bishop Folda has asked every family to please consider enthroning your home with the images of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary; which would coincide with having your home blessed. Although the hearts of Jesus and Mary have been venerated together for centuries, it was not until recently that we have begun to penetrate more deeply into the oneness existing between them.

Jacinta told Lucia, "Tell everybody that God grants us graces through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, that people are to ask her for them and that the Heart of Jesus wants the Immaculate Heart to be venerated at His side. Tell them also to pray to the Immaculate Heart for peace in the world, since God has entrusted it to her." (Sister Lucia, Memoirs, P. 337)

Pope John Paul II stated at a symposium in September 1986, "Since the Hearts of Jesus and Mary are joined forever in love, we know that to be loved by the Son is also to be loved by His mother. It is my prayer that your invitation will make an alliance of the hearts of Jesus and Mary better understood and appreciated by the people of God and thus promote devotion to the Heart of the Son and His mother in our day." 12 Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus:

1. I will give them all the graces necessary in their state in life.
2. I will establish peace in their homes.
3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions
4. I will be their secure refuge during life and above all in death.
5. I will bestow a large blessing upon all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls will grow fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
9. I will bless every place where a picture of My Heart is set & honored.
10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who promote this devotion shall have their names written in My heart, never to be blotted out.
12. I promise you in the excessive mercy of My heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who communicate on the First Friday in nine consecutive months the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their Sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.



To reiterate my exhortation at the pulpit this weekend, the Fatima magazine ran a story that in the 1980's there was a city in Pennsylvania that was hit by a tornado. The homes that were consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary had little or no damage by the tornado. The homes that were not consecrated were severely damaged or destroyed. The priest was so busy running around and doing everyone else's home that he did not do his rectory, and he came home to a rectory that was leveled to the ground and totally destroyed. I pray that you will take the message of Fatima and its principles seriously.

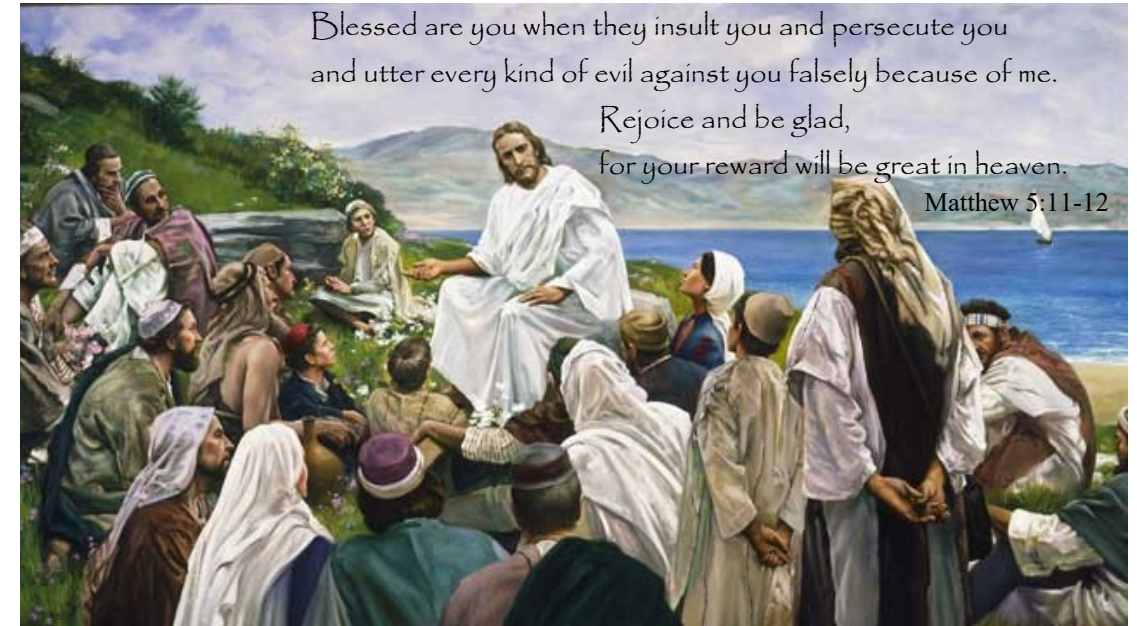


The message of Fatima by our Lady has three principles:
