Join us for the opportunity of a lifetime. This is not just a trip; this is a pilgrimage with the purpose of honoring God. It is a time of prayer and witness to special places in our Church. Since the earliest times, such journeys have been made as acts of devotion, penance, or thanksgiving or in search of blessings or miracles. The journey is full of joyful anticipation, temporarily separating the pilgrim from the world and offering him/herself to God. A pilgrim returns home transformed, renewed and restored by the abundant blessings received.

Tentative Schedule:

- Day 1** - Travel
- Day 2** - Cana of Galilee (Church of the Wedding Feast). Nazareth (Mass at the Church of the Annunciation). Mary's Well. Church of St. Joseph. Mt. Tabor. Church of Transfiguration. Baptism site on Jordan River.
- Day 3** - Capernaum (St. Peter's Primacy and Tabgha). Mass at Church on Mt. of Beatitudes. Boat ride in the Sea of Galilee.
- Day 4** - Baniyas (Caesarea Philippi). Valley of Armageddon, Druze Villages, Mt. Carmel. Muhrakha. Stella Maris. Eljiah's cave. Mass at Stella Maris.
- Day 5** - Jericho. Zaccheus's Tree. Mt. of Temptation. Mass at Qasr el Yahud – Baptism Site on River Jordan. Dead Sea. Jerusalem.
- Day 6** - Lazarus' tomb in Bethany. Mass at Bethany (Franciscan Church). Mt. of Olives. Garden of Gethsemane. Church of Ascension and Pater Noster. Dormition Church on Mt. Zion. Holy

- Hour at the Church of All Nations at Gethsemane.
 - Day 7** - Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Old city of Jerusalem through St. Stephen's Gate. Church of St. Ann. Pool of Bethesda. Mass at the Church of the Flagellation. Walk along the Stations of the Cross on Via Dolorosa carrying one large cross per group. Pass the Ecce Homo Arch and Condemnation Chapel. Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Rock of Calvary and The Holy Tomb. Temple Area. Western Wall. Walk through oriental bazaars.
 - Day 8** - Various options include visiting the room of the Last Supper, City of David, and Mass at the Caenacle.
 - Day 9** - Bethlehem. Shopping before Mass at the Church of Nativity. Birthplace of our Lord (Manger Scene), Grotto of Milk Church. Shepards Field Church. Good bye dinner at local Christian restaurant (Tent's at Shepherds' Field).
 - Day 10** - Travel

We cover the images to take the focus off the images and focus the attention of the people on the central mysteries of our faith -- the death and resurrection of Jesus.
