“Flowers in a permanent vase on the grave marker or cement base could remain until October 1. If not in a vase they will be allowed one week before Memorial Day until July 1. Live flowers not taken care of will be disposed of when wilted at time of mowing. No markers would be allowed in the middle of a grave if the ashes were placed on the grave of a relative. Grave markers would be allowed at the foot end of the grave or at the head end if there is room.”

St. Philip Neri Finance Council met on Wednesday, May 28, 2015 in the Parish Center at 4:30 p.m. Members present were Dennis Weigel, Cheri Glatt, Jim Bitz and Terry Schwanzenberger. Father presented a draft of what parish tithing may look like. It was decided to make additional parking by removing green space in parking lot. The current asphalt lot would have stripes painted to allow for orderly parking. God’s Gift Appeal Chairperson Cheri Glatt reported that the parish has collected \$53,256 which is 150% of goal of \$35,510. The parish experienced 64% of its members participating with 180 donors to date.

The Church is called to be the house of the Father, with doors always wide open ... #47 from *Evangelii Gaudium* by Pope Francis

### **Local buzz: (what is coming up in people's prayer & study)**

A parishioner offered this: Jesus can't be forced on these people. An invitation to a meal is a great idea. Keeping it small. Build trust and enforce confidentiality. There needs to be a trust built with each other. Slowly bring in the gospel, personal prayer, etc. There are people out there that need trustworthy friends. I totally believe in what Mallon is saying and it is going to take time to bring people closer to God.

Another 's feedback - In *Evangelii Gaudium*, Pope Francis says in # 24 "An evangelizing community gets involved by word and deed in people's daily lives; it bridges distances; It is willing to abase itself, if necessary, and it embraces human life, touching the suffering flesh of Christ in others." - If we do not know people and encounter them and what is going on in their lives, how can we help them grow in their faith? Need to contact people (touch base with them). Could be verbal, written. Use of technology to contact people. (eg: website feedback section, texts, offer webinars for people to gather as one).
