## **Fortnight for Freedom - Let's Pray**

The U.S. Bishops have called for a Fortnight for Freedom from June 21 to July 4, 2015. As a parish we will pray the litany after each Tuesday night Mass during this time period.

### **Parish Renewal: Prayer & Study Phase**

The Holy Spirit is calling us to be a parish that is: **Sacraments & Catechesis**

**Sacraments:** The cultural changes of the last 50 years have revealed existing fault lines in this sacramental system. Because the culture no longer compels people towards a connection with the Church, this connection has rapidly faded. At the same time, our pastoral models are essentially the same as those used before the cultural landslide of the last 50 years. What we are left with is the experience of sacraments that have practically no relation to discipleship, at least for those who have not yet become disciples, yet their original context was that they were rooted in discipleship. #87 *Divine Renovation* by Fr. What is the cost when a pastor, before the congregation, asks parents of children being baptized, "Do you clearly understand what you are undertaking?" and they say "yes" – and then most never return? How long can we keep this up, when this witnessing of unfulfilled promises begins to make our own "yes" to the demands of Christ and the Gospel more difficult to fulfill? #91 *Divine Renovation* by Fr. **Catechesis:** ... unless the kerygma or first proclamation is heard and received, all other steps in the process of making "missionary disciples" are "condemned to sterility." Attempting to catechize families who have not been evangelized is like trying to plant seeds in concrete. #95 *Divine Renovation* by Fr. Mallon

"Catechesis ought to be occasional and lifelong. We have made it continuous and terminal." #96 *Divine Renovation* by Fr. Mallon
