We are the Body of Christ. What has been coming up in your prayer and study regarding our Church being a community? Here are a few Scriptural quotes to reflect on.

Act 2:44-47 All who believed were together and had all things in common; 45 they would sell their property and possessions and divide them among all according to each one's need. 46 Every day they devoted themselves to meeting together in the temple area and to breaking bread in their homes. They ate their meals with exultation and sincerity of heart, 47 praising God and enjoying favor with all the people. And every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.

Act 4:32 Now the company of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things which he possessed was his own, but they had everything in common.

Most people join, stay and leave churches not because of belief, but because of a sense of belonging, because of community. The old order of behaving-believing-belonging has been reversed. ... Beliefs are changed not by preaching and teaching, but by building trust through relationships, through caring, through belonging. The implications of this new reality for us as a Church are huge. #57 Divine Renovation by Fr. Mallon

### **Local buzz: (what is coming up in our prayer & study)**

In reading the Acts of the Apostles 14:19-28 - this came to me ... the **importance of community and gathering together** ... for instance when Paul was stoned, the disciples gathered around him, he got up ... I am assuming they probably prayed over him (healing) .. the other part was ..; they called the Church together and reported what God had done with them; the **importance of witnessing, sharing how Jesus is/was working in them and their lives.** The Gospel this day was John 14:27-31a - Here the two verses that stood out were - "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." --here the importance of prayer; as peace is always ours when we spend time with Jesus ... it is **something this world cannot give.** And then **not being afraid** to share with others what happens to us when we encounter Jesus.
